Rep. May Honored for Having Most Independent Voting Record

HIGHLAND PARK, IL – State Rep. Karen May, D-Highland Park, has been chosen by the Independent Voters of Illinois-Independent Precinct Organization (IVI-IPO) for the 2008 Best Legislative Voting Record.

“I appreciate the recognition of my independence in voting,” said May. “I truly encourage and consider input from constituents before casting my vote.”

The Independent Voters of Illinois-Independent Precinct Organization was first created in 1944. It is a not-for-profit, independent political organization dedicated to government activism and the vision of open and honest government in Illinois. Each year the IVI-IPO Board of Directors selects members of the Illinois General Assembly for their “Best Legislative Voting Record Awards.” This year, 6 senators and 10 representatives were chosen from the 177 members of the Assembly. May received the highest rating of all the members of the General Assembly, earning a score of 95%.

“I am grateful to the IVI-IPO for being such good advocates for transparency in the lawmaking process and for recognizing lawmakers who truly work for the people of their districts,” May said.
