## **Rep. May Honored by IVI for Legislative Voting Record**

**HIGHLAND PARK** – State Rep. Karen May, D-Highland Park, has been chosen by the Independent Voters of Illinois-Independent Precinct Organization (IVI-IPO) for the 2006 Best Legislative Voting Record.

“I am honored to have been named for this recognition,” May said. “As elected officials, our top priority is to pass legislation that improves the quality of life for residents in our district and Illinois. It is very gratifying and encouraging when constituents and organizations support us and believe in the work that we are doing.”

The Independent Voters of Illinois-Independent Precinct Organization was first created in 1944. It is a not-for-profit, independent political organization dedicated to government activism and the vision of open and honest government in Illinois. Each year the IVI-IPO Board of Directors selects members of the Illinois General Assembly for their 2006 Best Legislative Voting Record Awards. This year, 11 senators and 17 representatives were chosen from the 177 members of the Assembly. The award ceremony will take place on September 10 at the Atrium Restaurant in Chicago.
